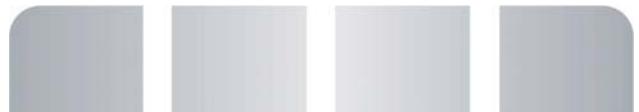

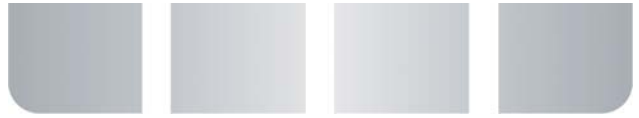

The system is also able to save notes and drawings so that they are ready to be uploaded for the next lesson. The Interactive Whiteboard is the first and only writing surface to receive SCS Indoor Advantage Gold and Cradle to Cradle Silver certification.

PolyVision will also be showcasing the ēno Mini, a mobile slate that lets teachers and students create and deliver presentations from anywhere in the classroom. The Mini allows students to participate in lessons from their seats and gives teachers the freedom to move around the class while continuing instruction.
